

EISB School Uniform Policy

Introduction

The wearing of full school uniform is expected as an integral part of the school ethos which promotes positive attitudes, high standards and a sense of personal pride. By sending your children to EISB, you are agreeing to follow this policy. In our view, for a school uniform to be successful it must be:

- UNIFORM and not open to various interpretations
- DISTINCTIVE and SMART
- REASONABLY PRICED
- EASILY and READILY AVAILABLE

Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform combination from the appropriate list below.

Years 1-6 Boys (bought from the online shop)

- Long navy socks (if wearing with shorts)
- Navy shorts
- Navy unisex trousers
- White polo shirt long sleeved with logo on chest and red stripe on cuff, no pocket
- White polo shirt short sleeved with logo on chest and red stripe on sleeve, no pocket
- Burgundy cardigan with buttons with logo
- Burgundy vest sweater with logo
- Burgundy V neck sweater with logo

Years 1-6 Girls (bought from the online shop)

- Navy knee length socks
- Short white socks (summer option)
- Navy tights
- Tartan plaid skirt
- Tartan plaid skort (shorts that look like a skirt)
- Pinafore: Plain Navy top with tartan skirt
- White polo shirt long sleeved with red stripe on sleeve and logo, no pocket
- White polo shirt short sleeved with red stripe on sleeve and logo, no pocket
- Burgundy cardigan with buttons with logo
- Burgundy vest sweater with logo
- Burgundy V neck sweater with logo
- Navy trousers: Elastic waist with no zip
- Navy Unisex trousers
- Navy shorts

PE Uniform

New white t shirt with navy short sleeves and logo on chest (bought from the online shop) Suitable navy coloured shorts (parents' choice) Suitable footwear or trainers depending on the external PE Unit.



Years 7-11 boys (bought from the online shop)

- Long navy socks (if wearing with shorts)
- Navy shorts
- Navy unisex trousers
- Formal navy trousers
- White formal shirt with collar long sleeved: Regular fit, No logo
- White formal shirt with collar short sleeved: Regular fit, No logo
- Burgundy cardigan with buttons with logo
- Burgundy vest sweater with logo
- Burgundy V neck sweater with logo

Years 7-11 girls (bought from the online shop)

- Long navy socks
- Navy tights
- Tartan plaid skirt
- Navy unisex trousers
- Girls navy trousers
- White open neck, v-collar formal blouse long sleeved: Slim fit and regular fit options
- White open neck, v-collar formal blouse short sleeved: Slim fit and regular fit options
- Burgundy cardigan with buttons with logo
- Burgundy vest sweater with logo
- Burgundy V neck sweater with logo

Diploma DRESS CODE (Years 12 & 13)

As ambassadors for the school who are young adults, EISB encourages learners in Years 12 and 13 to dress business-casual in clothing chosen by the students if they do not wear the prescribed school uniform. However, students should be smart, tidy and clean in all aspects of their appearance.

Footwear

Shoes should be conservative, clean and smart. Bottom of shoes should not mark the floors. Years 1-6 – Closed-toe shoes (no crocs or flip-flops). Exception is for orthopedic shoes on parent request. Years 7+ - Closed-toe shoes (no Crocs), no high heals

Jewelry

No face piercings.

Make up

Make up is not permitted in Primary years. Make up is permitted in Secondary but should be minimal, sensible and appropriate for a school setting.
