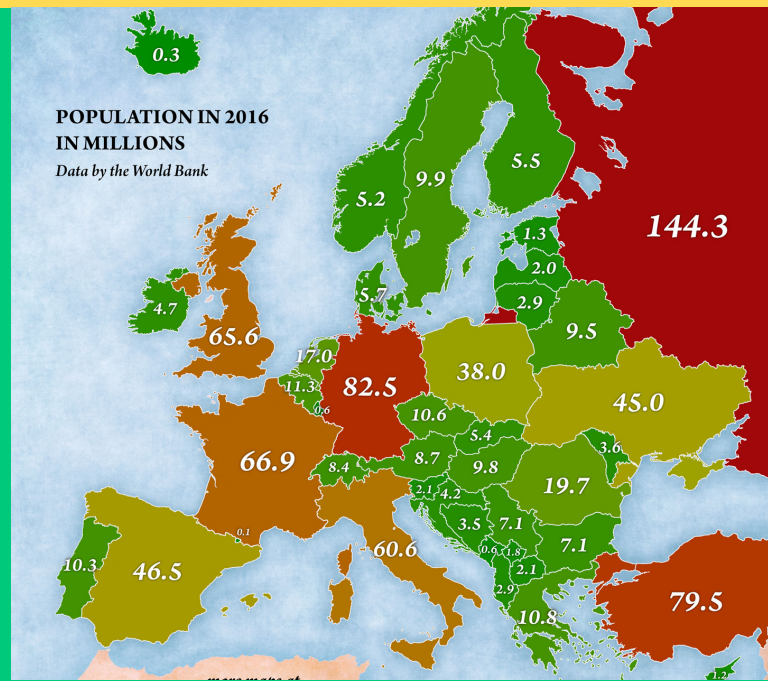
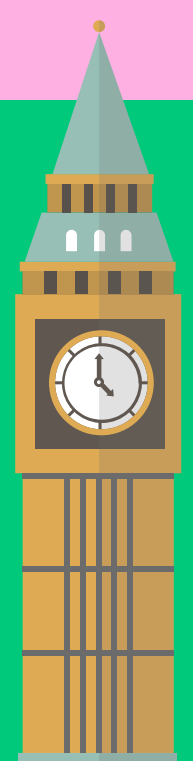


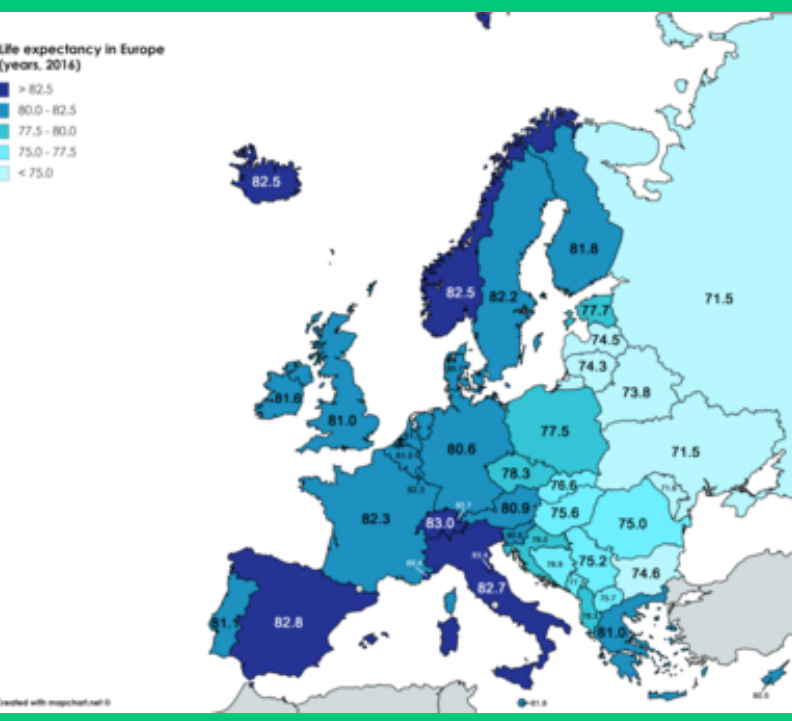
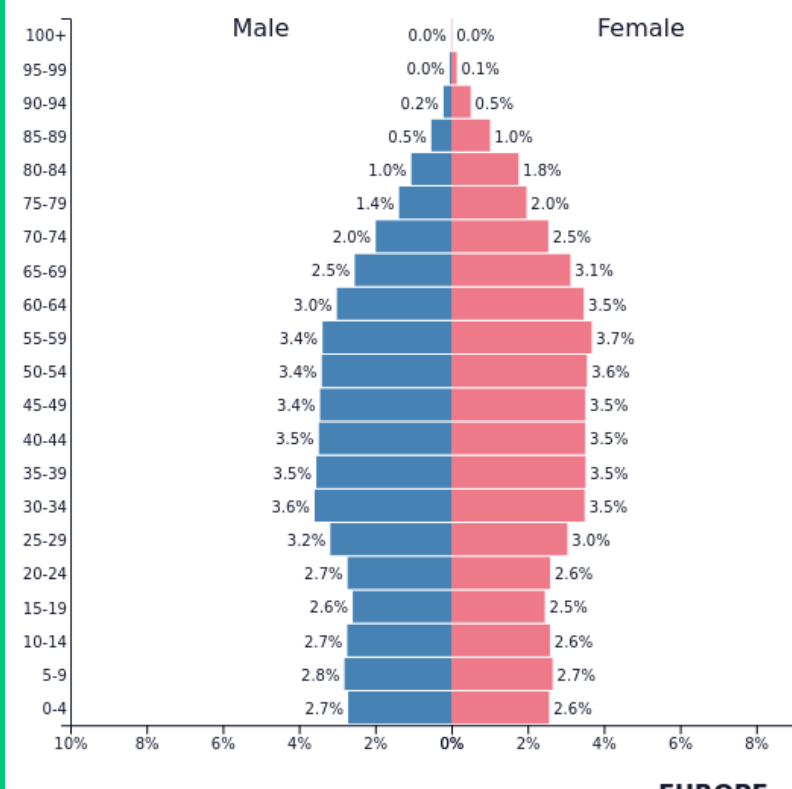
European Population

The population of Europe is 748 million people

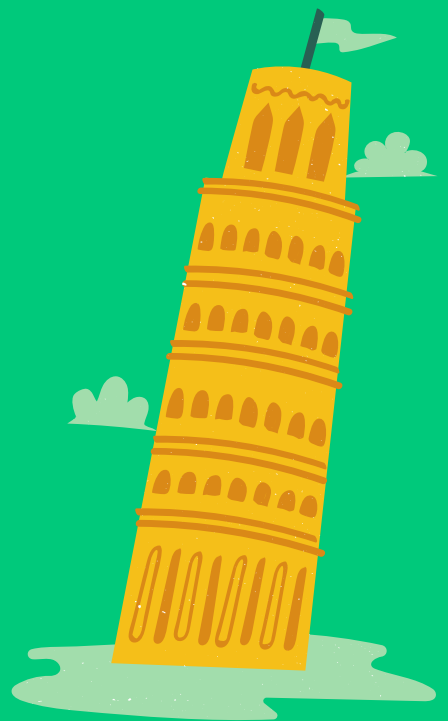
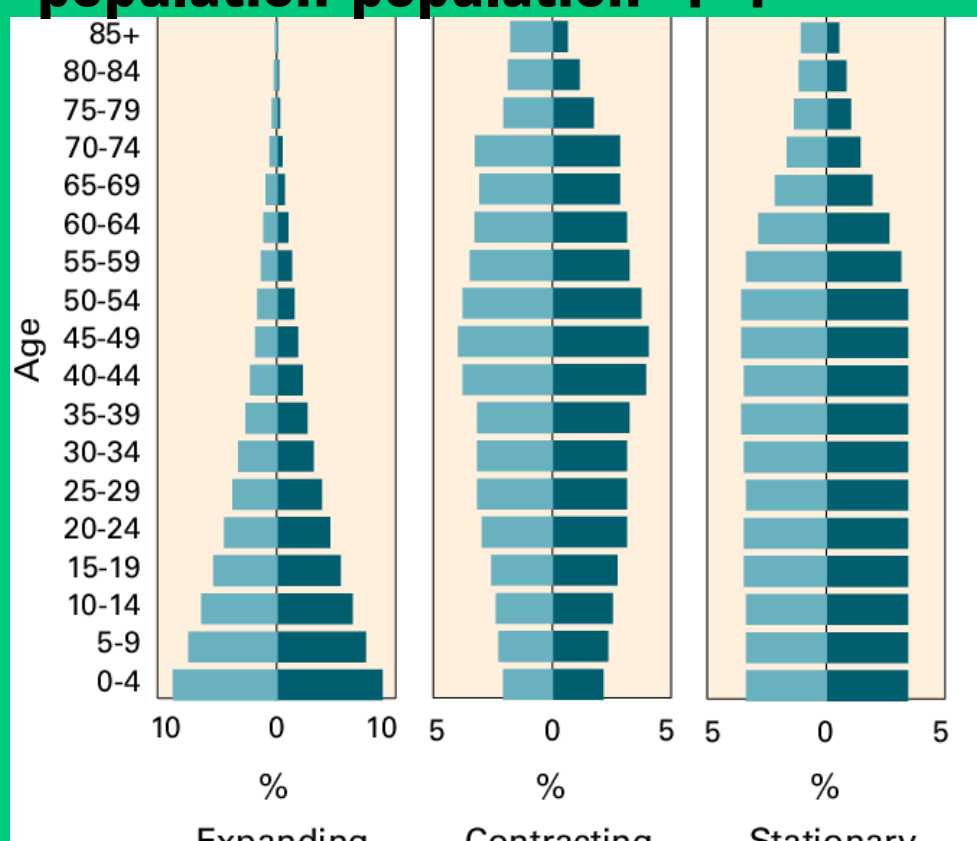


This shows the life expectancy in European countries. The average is 81 years.
